Invertebrate Project Coordinator

Do you have a passion for invertebrate conservation? We are looking for someone to take on the role of Invertebrate Project Coordinator within our Conservation Team. You will work with the National Park Wardens and our project partners to conduct Ascension's first comprehensive survey of terrestrial invertebrates and incorporate into the island's conservation management actions. This will involve field surveys, specimen preservation and identification, plan development and public outreach.

You must be resilient and adaptable in order to thrive in what can be a challenging environment. The successful applicant will need to be capable of working autonomously as well as part of the wider Conservation Team to deliver this ambitious project. In addition, you will need to have good interpersonal skills that allow you to work well as a team, lead groups of volunteers and participate in public engagement events.

More details about the roles and the skills and experience required are provided in the Job Description. We are offering a two year, single status contract with a salary of £12,000 (taxable in Ascension).

For the successful candidates we will provide:

- Single Status food allowance (£3,350)

- One mid-contract return journey to your country of recruitment
